

Franklin County Treasurer System Integration

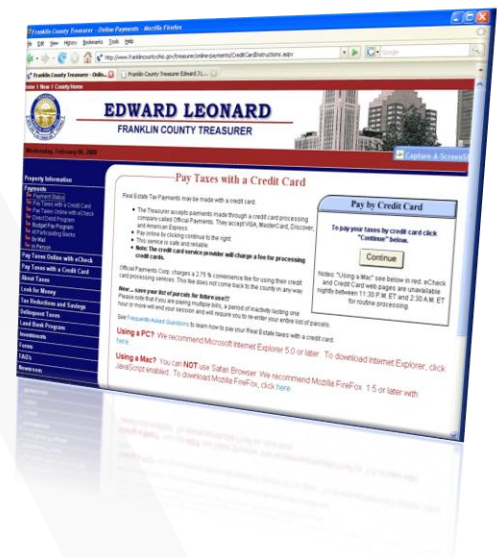

ATGi successfully led a development effort - delivering an integrated application while training and mentoring a development team to take ownership of the application – for the Franklin County Treasurer.

ATGi worked with the Franklin County Treasurer to integrate all the Treasurer’s information systems into a single unified application. The Franklin County Treasurer System (FCTS) started as sixteen unique applications. Some of these applications were written by programming staff and others were written by end users keeping track of individualized data. ATGi worked with the Treasurer’s staff to analyze the use of each application and to review the intended operations of the office. With the requirements compiled, ATGi recommended an ASP.NET application with a SQL Server database be built in phased modules. ATGi was also charged with training Franklin County Data Center staff on the ASP.NET platform by keeping their developers involved throughout the effort. After a week-long .NET training session for the Data Center Staff, ATGi’s business analyst and lead developer began working with the Data Center to design the required application modules.

In the end, twelve integrated modules were released for FCTS as phased replacements for the original sixteen ad-hoc applications. The Treasurer’s office moved to FCTS in its entirety by December of 2006. The Franklin County Data Center was fully responsible for application maintenance by February of 2007. ATGi was retained to provide further enhancements to this critical system. During this project we were able to give the Data Center staff more ownership of the application by coaching them in the independent design and development of major system modules.
